Currently serving as the Director of Operations for Corporate Emergency Management at Northwell, Tim leads a multidisciplinary team supporting preparedness for New York State's largest healthcare system. This includes ensuring regulatory agency compliance, developing comprehensive training programs, and overseeing system-wide preparedness efforts across 23 hospitals and 87 ambulatory locations.
